LETTER OF AGREEMENT ESTABLISHING CAMP USE, NON SCOUT GROUP

This letter of agreement is for the purpose of establishing the use of CAMP: _____

ORG: _____ agrees to provide the South Texas Council, Scouting America, with the required documents listed below at least a week prior to the event:

- A certificate of liability insurance with a minimum of \$2,000,000, combined single limit with the South Texas Council, Scouting Americas, and the National Council, Scouting America, named as additional insured, ten (10) day written notice of cancellation, and the period of time involved.
- A Hold Harmless Agreement. (copy attached)
- A roster showing the names of all persons participating in this activity.

It is understood and agreed to by both parties that the fee for use of the following facilities:

_____, and is required to be paid at the Council Office prior to arrival at camp.

It is understood and agreed to by both parties that _____ shall be responsible for any and all damages to camp property which may reasonably be attributed to the actions of said group agrees to promptly pay any and all reasonable damage claims when presented.

It is understood and agreed by both parties that no alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, fireworks, or chain saws of any kind are permitted or to be used on the premises.

It is understood and agreed by both parties that _____ will provide a minimum of two adult leaders (defined herein as individuals 21 years of age or older) for all youth participants. In addition, one additional adult leader shall be provided for every ten (10) participants under the age of 21 present in camp. At least one of the designated adult leaders must remain with the group at all times while the group is in camp. Co-ed groups are required to provide both a male and a female adult leader, in accordance with the ratio of required adults for every ten (10) youth participants under the age of 21.

It is understood and agreed to by both parties that the group will abide by any and all of the camp operating rules and directions.

It is further understood and agreed to by both parties that should the group fail to provide proper leadership or fail to abide by camp rules or directions of the South Texas Council, this agreement may be terminated and require the renting parties to vacate the camp, forfeiting any and all fees and monies agreed to herein.
